**DELAYED START or SCHOOL CLOSURE
DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER**

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

During the winter months, it may become impossible for buses to travel some roads, especially at higher elevations. By law, bus drivers may not go into any area where fog has created extreme reduced visibility (less than 200 feet), or snow and/or black ice have made road conditions too hazardous.

DELAYED START OR SCHOOL CLOSURE PROCEDURES (DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER).

NOTIFICATION

- **First listen to television or radio stations listed below.** Severe weather could delay the start of school (add the amount of hourly delay amount announced, to your students usual bus pick-up time to calculate the delayed bus pick-up time, for example:
Normal pick-up is 7:22 am add 2 hour announced delay = 9:22 am) or cause a closure of schools district wide. Radio and TV stations will be requested to announce this information as early as 6:00 a.m.
- Call RUSD Transportation if you need bus service information.
- If necessary contact the District Office or your students School Office.

SINGLE SCHOOL SITE CLOSURE (DURING SCHOOL HOURS)

The individual school site will follow these procedures:

- Students will be safely transported by district buses to another designated school site.
- Parents will be notified through the individual school site phone tree and the radio / television emergency information network.
- Students who normally ride the bus will be transported home at their regularly scheduled time, if possible, from the alternate site.

DISTRICT- WIDE SCHOOL CLOSURE (DURING SCHOOL HOURS)

Rescue Union School District will follow these procedures:

- Parents will be notified through the individual school site phone tree and the radio / television emergency information network.
- Students will be assembled in the multi-purpose rooms awaiting pickup by parents or possible transportation by bus.

RESCUE U.S.D. EAST / WEST ELEVATION VARIANCE

The eastern portion of the district (elevation 1300 ft.) may experience hazardous weather conditions, snow/black ice or unsafe reduced visibility and at the same time the western portion of the district (elevation 500 ft.) may only be experiencing moderate rain. Closure of all school sites within the district may be decided because transportation and other support services are linked to all sites, and all schools would be affected.
